


HINGE LOCK REPLACEMENT,



- 3. Inspect the ladder before installing this kit. Repair or replace any damaged or missing parts before using the ladder. Use only Little Giant Ladder Systems® replacement parts. If you are unable to repair it, discard the ladder.











1. Remove the outer assemblies from the inner assembly.




2. Open the ladder to the extended position to remove the existing hinge lock.




3. If the ladder has a black cap on the palm button, continue to next step. If it does not have a palm button cap skip to step 6.




5. Use the punch to pry the cap off from the palm button. Be careful to not hurt your fingers or hands. The black cap can be discarded.




7. Remove the palm button from the shaft of the hinge lock.




4. Using a drill and 3/16" bit, drill through one of the corners of the black cap as shown. Only drill enough to get through the black cap. If you happen to hit the orange part of the palm button it is okay, this will be discarded.




6. Use the snap ring pliers to remove the snap ring. Discard the removed snap ring.




8. Use snap ring pliers to remove the snap ring. Discard the removed snap ring.



9. Pull the hinge lock from the hinge plates. Dispose of the removed hinge lock.




11. Notice the notch running along the bottom edge of the hole. This groove must remain in line while inserting the new hinge lock.




13. Only use the snap ring supplied in the kit.
Install the large snap ring by placing it in the groove of the barrel. Make sure it is completely seated.




10. If the barrel of the hinge lock remains in the hinge plates, hit the corner of the barrel with a hammer and chisel to remove. Take care not to damage the hinge plate.



12. Insert the new hinge lock, lining up the nipple on the barrel with the notch, which goes through the center of the hinge. Also, align the four lock pins with the four holes in the hinge.




14. Replace the palm button as shown in the illustration.



15. Replace the final (small) snap ring, making sure it is completely seated in the groove before using the hinge.



16. Re-install the outer assembly onto the inner assembly.



17. If applicable, align tabs on new cap with holes in palm button, then push in until tabs clip into place. Make sure all components are secure and functioning properly before returning ladder to service.
