



## SEPARATION STOPPER INSTALLATION

Procedure for installing the separation stopper on Little Giant Ladder Systems **Extension** ladders.

- 1. Failure to comply with all instructions may result in serious injury.
- 2. Make sure this kit is compatible with your ladder. If you have any questions concerning the use of this kit on Little Giant Ladder Systems products, call 800-453-1192 for assistance.
- 3. Before installing this kit, identify all kit components. If any components are missing or damaged, please contact Customer Care. Do not substitute any components.
- 4. Inspect the ladder before installing this kit. Repair or replace any damaged or missing ladder parts before using the ladder. Use only Little Giant Ladder Systems repair or replacement parts. If you are unable to repair it, discard the ladder.


(2) CENTER LOCK NUTS

5/32" ALLEN WRENCH






1. Lay the ladder on its back to make the following steps easier.




2. Identify the area on the ladder in which you will be working.




3. Measure 13" from the bottom of the rail on the fly and 9/16" (roughly .56") from the sides of the rail, and then make a mark.




4. Drill a 17/64" hole at the mark.




5. Place the bolt and spacer through the top of the rail, below the rail add the washer and the nut.



6. Tighten with 7/16" wrench and 5/32" Allen wrench.



7. Repeat the process to install the second stopper to the other rail, as shown in the illustration.



8. Once all of the steps are completed, stand the ladder back up and make sure that it is completely stable before use.
