





1. Identify the Select Step handle that needs to be replaced.




2. Pull up on the handle.




3. Twist the handle to release the outer section from the inner.




5. Lay the ladder on its side to make the following steps easier.




7. Using a Phillips head screwdriver, loosen and remove the (existing) screw holding the handle in place. (Once free, discard the existing screw)



4. Slide the inner section down, position the handle between the comfort step and the middle retention bar to make the following steps easier.



6. Using a flathead screwdriver, pop the (existing) screw cap off of the handle. (Once free, discard the existing screw cap)



8. Remove the (existing) handle, and discard.







Figure 1 Figure 2



9. Line up the openings on the bottom of the (new) handle (as seen in Figure 1) with the bars on the ladder (as seen in Figure 2). When they are aligned, the handle should slide into place.




10. Using a Phillips head screwdriver, insert and tighten the (new) screw.



11. Using your thumb, pop the (new) screw cap into place.



12. Stand the ladder back up and slide the inner section up into the "standard" position.



13. Rotate the Handle back into its "home" position.



14. Once all of the steps have been completed, make sure the ladder is completely stable before use.
